 - shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars: that no Director has been convicted in any Country for any
 - criminal offence relating to fraud or financial impropriety or criminal misrepresentation or falsification of facts relating to that the Company is not in receivership, the subject of any form
 - of insolvency or bankruptcy proceedings or the subject of any form of winding up petition or proceedings;
- Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years 2020, 2021 & 2022;
- Reference Letter from a reputable Commercial Bank in Nigeria, indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of
- the project when needed; Company's Profile with the Curriculum Vitae of Key Staff to be
- deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic/Professional qualifications such as COREN, QSRBN, ARCON, CORBON etc.; Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs (in size, nature & complexity) executed in the last five (5) years

- including Letters of Awards, Valuation Certificates, Job Completion Certificates and Photographs of the projects:
- For Supply of Equipment: Letter of Authorisation as representative of the Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEMs):
 - Works: List of Plants/Equipment with proof of Ownership/Lease Agreement:
- For Joint Venture/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided (CAC, Tax Clearance Certificate, Pension n Clearance Certificate, ITF Compliance Certificate, NSITF Clearance Certificate, IRR & Sworn Affidavit are compulsory for each JV
- All documents for submission must be transmitted with a Covering/Forwarding letter under the Company/Firm's Letter Head Paper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC) as issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), Contact Address, Telephone Number (preferably GSM No.), and e-mail address. The Letterhead Paper must bear the Names and Nationalities of the Directors of the Company at the bottom of the page, duly signed by the authorised officer of the firm.

COLLECTION OF TENDER DOCUMENTS: Interested Bidders should collect Bid documents from the Procurement

Unit at COREN Headquarters, Abuja upon payment of non-refundable fee of Ten Thousand Naira Only (N10,000,00) via COREN TSA in any reputable Commercial Bank in Nigeria.

5.0 SUBMISSION OF TENDER DOCUMENTS Prospective bidders are to submit bid for each of the Lot desired, two (2) hard copies each of the technical and financial bids with softcopy of financial bid only in MS Excel format, packaged separately in sealed

envelopes and clearly marked as "Technical Bid" or "Financial Bid". Thereafter, put the two sealed envelopes together in a bigger sealed envelope addressed to the Registrar, Council for the Regulation of Engineering in Nigeria, 22, Addis Ababa Crescent, Wuse Zone 4. Abuia. The envelope should be clearly marked with (the name of the project and the Lot number). Furthermore, the reverse of each sealed envelope should bear the name and address of the bidder and drop in the designated Tender Box not later than 12:00 noon Wednesday, 3rd May, 2023.
